
Literacy Chicago's mission is to empower individuals to achieve greater self sufficiency through language and literacy instruction.



BARBARA BUSH FOUNDATION FOR FAMILY LITERACY Percent of adults who have received public assistance








Literacy Gap Map

Who are low level readers?




- Average level: 4th grade

- Average age: 26-58
- 50-50 gender split
