United4Youth is a community **empowerment** model – assembling teams of organizations to co-design innovative **collaborative programs** that lead to positive and sustainable outcomes for our highest needs youth.

United4Youth encompasses a broad scope of offerings for youth and their families– not simply a single service – that must **work together to make a positive change** in participants' lives. The idea behind community impact is to look at participant needs beyond just the services offered by a single program, and **integrate services** to provide a full spectrum of personal and social solutions.

With **6 organizations** coming together to serve **South County youth**, the idea is that social needs are not the result of a single condition, but more likely reflect a combination of conditions, each of which should be addressed to bring about a positive, sustainable change.

- The collaboration is working on community impact by increasing **cross referrals** and maintaining a **no-closed door policy**.
- Representatives of each organization meet regularly to explore how to meaningfully support our youth with the longer term goal of addressing the root issues and changes needed to create a thriving community.

As part of our collaboration we also provide a **6-8 week series of workshops** that we bring to a school or organization to wrap around a designated group of students. (Sessions might be modified to comply with CDC guidelines during COVID pandemic and be provided virtually or outdoors with smaller groups)

By working together, we empower our youth to grow in a safe, healthy, and thriving community.

Living Evolution/ Growing Up Wild

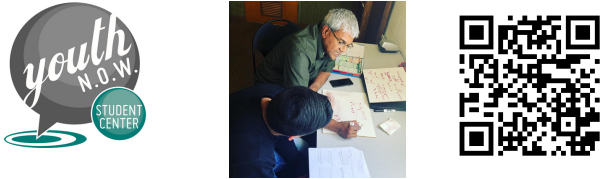
MISSION: To create a stronger sense of community, increase physical and mental health, and support people in experiencing a greater sense of connection to nature.
