- It also has the power to overturn laws



- Ruth Bader Ginsburg also known by her initials RBG, was a Supreme Court Justice from 1993 until her death in 2020.
- RBG was nominated by President Bill Clinton and spent most of her career advocating for gender equality and women's rights.



- Sonia Sotomayor is a United States Supreme Court justice.
- She is the first and only Latina on the Court. Sonia Sotomayor is Puerto Rican and is from the Bronx.

- Dr. Kizzmekia Corbett is an African American viral immunologist on the front lines of the global research for COVID-19 vaccines.
- Dr. Kizzmekia Corbett's research helped develop the Moderna vaccine for COVID-19 which continues to save millions of lives.

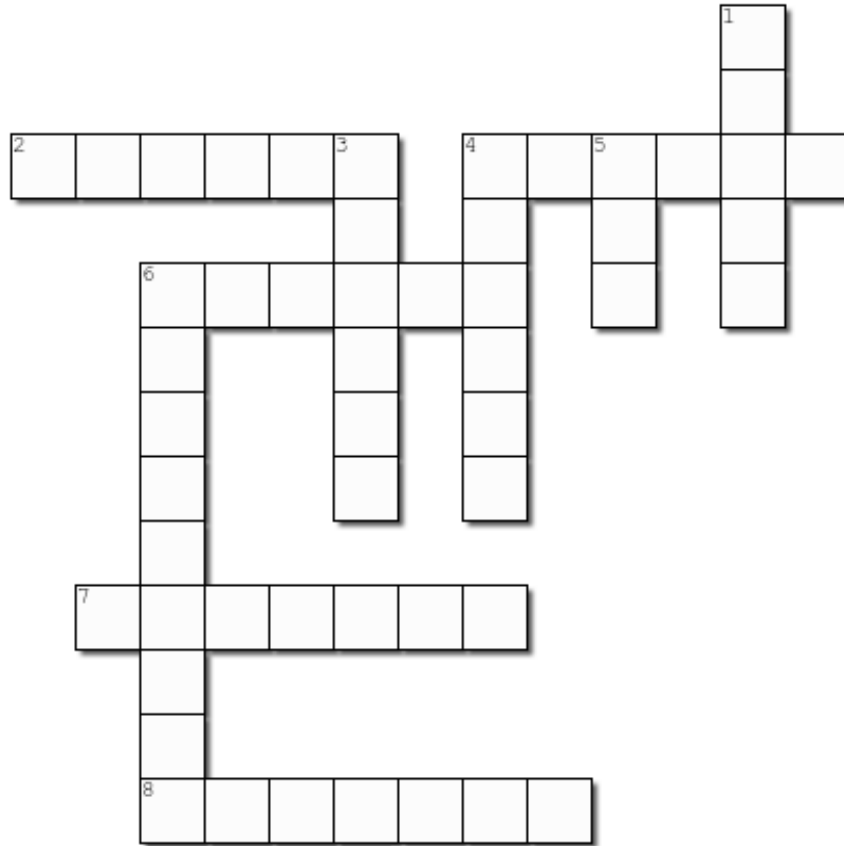


- Dr. Mae Carol Jemison is an American engineer, physician, and former NASA astronaut.

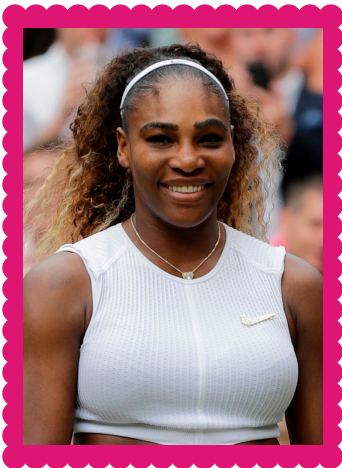

- She is the youngest person to ever win the Nobel Peace Prize.



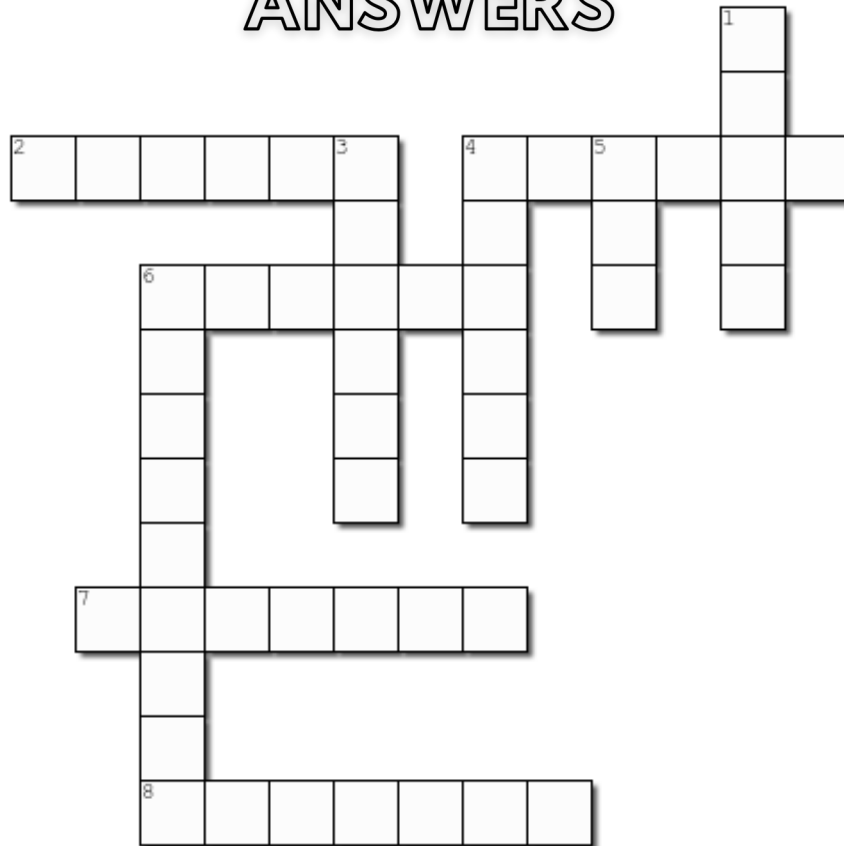
- Serena Williams is a professional tennis player.

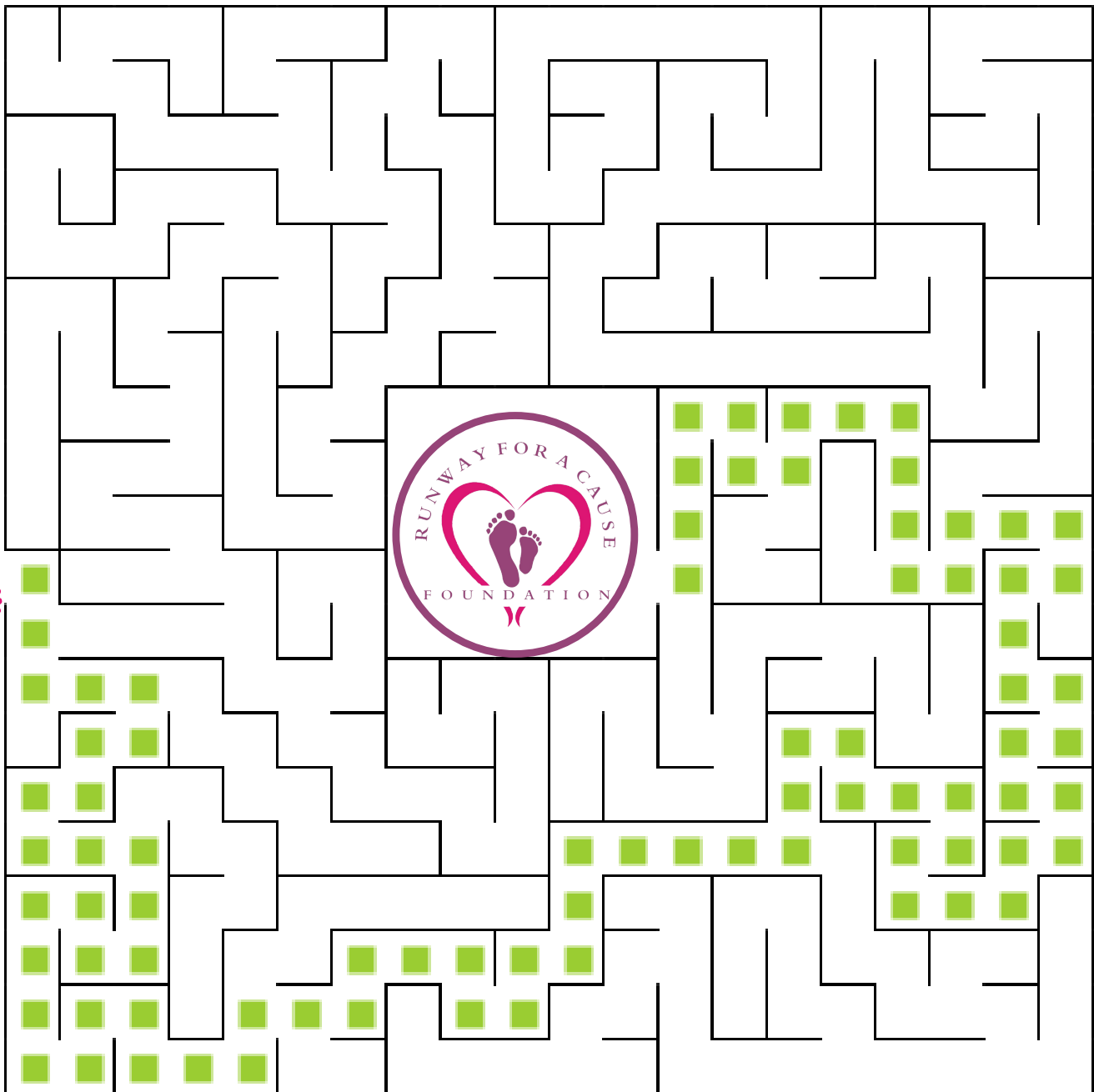

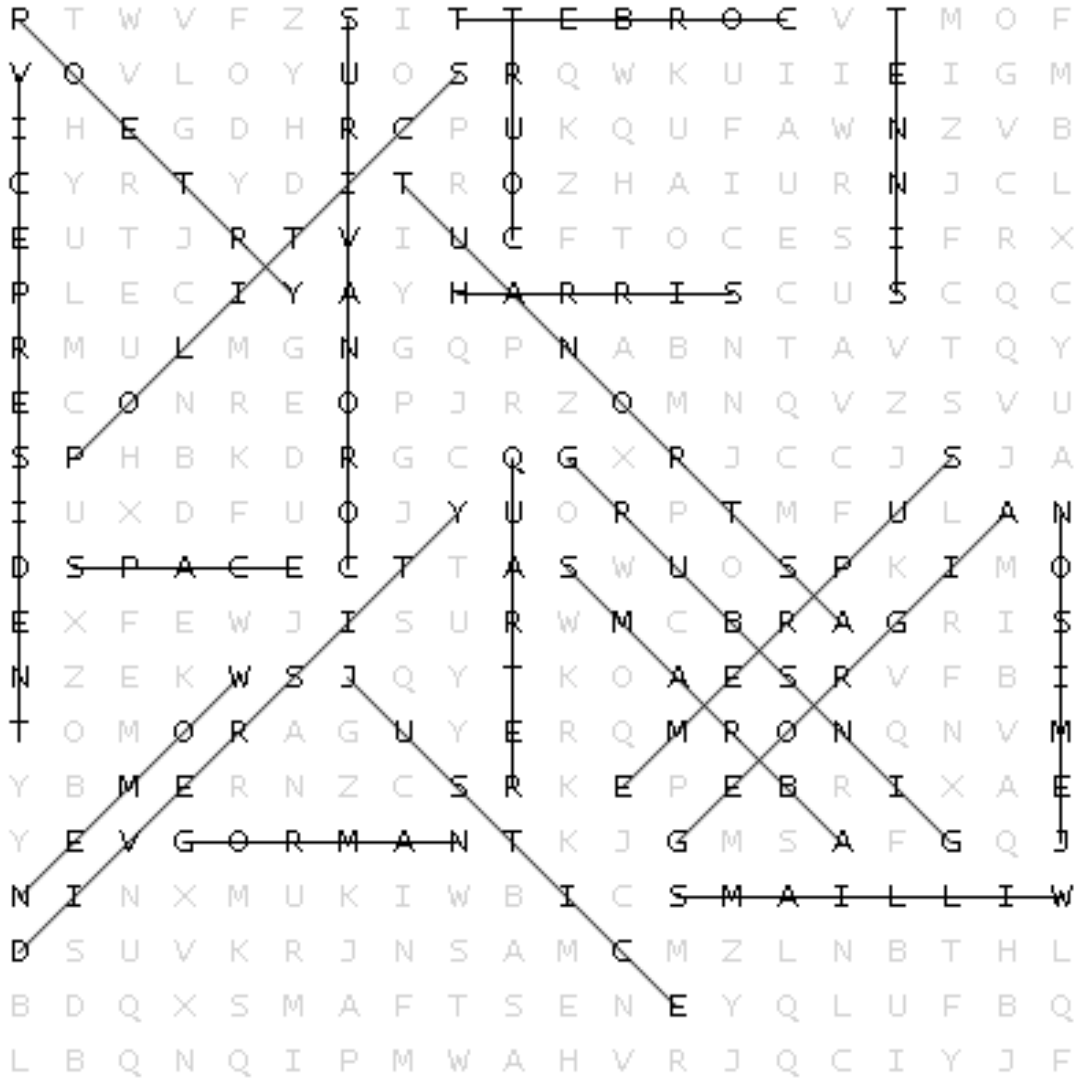
