We went patrolling for nurdles along the Ohio River with Mountain Watershed Association. Nurdles are very small pellets of plastic that are used as the raw material in the manufacturing of plastic products.






SAMPLING WATER QUALITY ALONG OUR THREE RIVERS

We are actively monitoring water quality along our three rivers. We seasonally sample 25 sites along our rivers for a variety of markers, such as anions, nutrients (such as Nitrogen), metals, and other water isotopes.
