

Water Quality Sampling, Nurdle Patrols, and Pollution Responses

This spring, we continued our monthly water sampling near the Shell Cracker Plant with 3 Rivers Quest and our monthly Nurdle patrol with Youghiogheny Riverkeeper.



During the spring we received and followed up with pollution reports at a Natrona Heights Tributary, a Homestead Drinking Water Source, along Saw Mill Run, and on the Monongahela River. We collected water samples and taking action when clean water laws are violated.






River Cleanups

<u>October 18th, 2022 marks the 50th Anniversary</u> <u>of the Signing of the Clean Water Act</u>

It will be a year of celebrating starting World Water Day on March 22nd through the 50th Anniversary

The Clean Water Act has significantly helped decrease the amount of pollution in our waterways, and we've seen the impact and improvement in our water quality. Nevertheless, there are still challenges facing our right to clean water, such as legal difficulties with enforcement of the Clean Water Act, limited resources for monitoring, and environmental deregulation.

Three Rivers Waterkeeper aims to reduce challenges and barriers to our right to clean water with the ACT50 Waterkeeper movement. ACT50 is a collective call for governments to unite with Waterkeepers and our communities in the fight for clean water. Working together, we can ensure that water is drinkable, fishable, and swimmable by enforcing laws, holding polluters accountable, and empowering citizens.


