Mentoring **11,584** youth to be community leaders

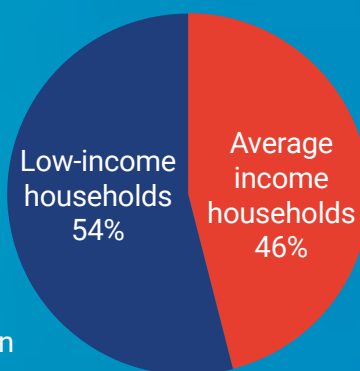
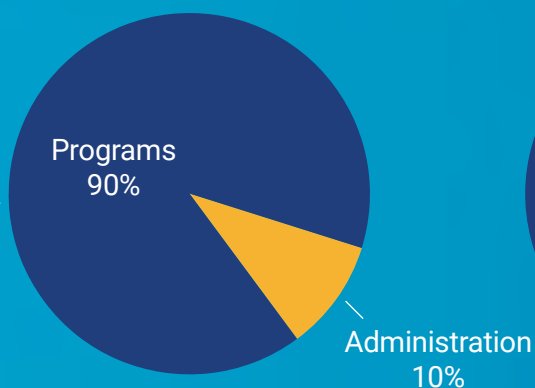

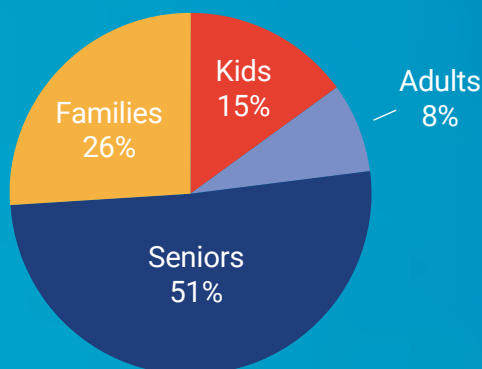
How are funds spent?



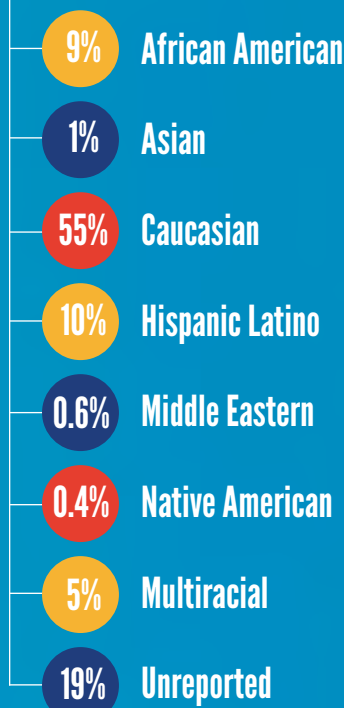

When a local apartment building was declared unsafe by county health and safety officials due to an insect infestation, we were there to help the 16 residents—nine adults and seven children—and their pets find more stable housing.
