# PAG Treasure/s Report tor February 2019 Board Meeting

- 1. Current bank balance as of 1/31/2019 is \$23,475.62. A copy of the bank statement and the January 2019 P&L statement and Balance Sheet are included with this report.
- A revised 2018 Profit and Loss Statement is also included, along with a Balance Sheet as of December 31, 2018. A minor revision to 2018 expenses was recorded as accounts were reconciled at year-end.
- 3. The PAG donation to Arapahoe Community College for **two S1,000 scholarships** was made in January. As previously reported, ACC provided matching funds so we are actually funding two \$2,000 scholarships in the name of Parker Artists Guild for 2019.
- 4. January expenses included a payment to Lunarpages (our website host) in the amount of \$178 for a 3-year renewal of our website hosting.
- Sales tax reports and payments were made in January to the Colorado Department of Revenue, the Town of Castle Rock and the Town of Parker covering the last of 2018 activity not previously reported.
- 6. The PAG Show titled 'Romancing the Arts' at the Library in Castle Rock reported Artist Show Participation fees totaling \$1,405. Based on the awards budget for the show and anticipated costs, this show is expected to break even or net a small amount. Two sales from the show have been confirmed to-date, with two other sales pending.
