#### **BUSINESS:**

### Introduction and President Comments - Bill

- ACC Scholarship update Bill received an email from ACC coordinator for scholarships indicating that ACC has not chosen a student for the scholarship due to absent information from the students that applied. - PAG board to define the policy of payment to presenters: Payment to speakers can be up to \$200 but not to exceed that limit which must be approved by the board prior to making decision for speaker fees. Leslie motions for PAG not to exceed \$200 for the payment to speakers, Vinton 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion carries.
- Bill and Vinton will discuss implementing a live calendar for PAG website. The calendar will reflect dates for everything PAG is involved in (venues, changeouts, meetings, shows, events, etc).
