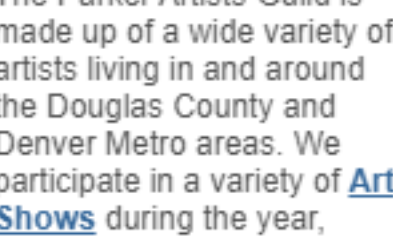


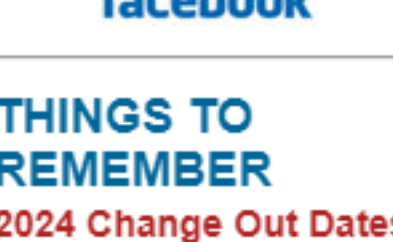

A lot is going on with the art guild!! I hope you can get involved and participate in some of the following Art Opportunities:

Parker Wine Walks - The Parker Artists Guild has rented the Plaza at the Schoolhouse for the first Parker Wine Walk on Friday, September 13, from 4:30 to 7:30.

Because we will be renting the plaza, we will be allowed to sell our artwork on the Schoolhouse property. Yeal

Artists will be responsible for their own sales, and will need to pay 8% tax to the town. We can set up tents, provided they are weighted, not staked into the ground. Free-standing grids for hanging your artwork will be permitted, as long as they are not staked into the ground. We can also set up artwork displays on the tables under the umbrellas. These will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Please bring something artistic to work on if you can.

Plein-air painting, woodworking, drawing, etc. all make people curious about what you are doing, so they stop by to check it out. Painting wine glasses, or having hand-painted wine glasses ready, might be a fun idea.

We will ask participating artists to donate \$30.00 to PAG to help us offset the costs.

If this goes well, we would like to rent the Plaza again for the Wine Walks on September 27 and October 11.

The deadline to enter is Saturday, September 28, at 10:00 pm.

We are charging a bit more to enter this show, so we can use the money collected to put toward prize money. It will be \$35 instead of \$25 to enter. The size of the prizes will depend on the number of entries we receive. The show will be juried, so not all entries will be accepted. It will also be judged (by 2 or 3 professional artists who are not familiar with our group). 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizes will be awarded.

We usually ask that you submit pieces that have not been shown at the schoolhouse before, but for this one, we will accept art that has been hung here in previous shows. Submit the best images of your best artwork!

Painting Children from Photographs in Oils.

September 27,28,29 at REAL Academy of Art Colorado. Cost is \$417

This three-day workshop will be all about how to paint the younger model. As a mother of two and a seasoned commissioned portrait artist, Anna has learned how to capture the spirit of youth that is often so difficult to master in portrait painting. She will discuss how to draw a child so they look their age, how to mix skin tones and paint hair, and she will also share some strategies for choosing good photo references. Each morning Anna will demonstrate from photo references by painting children of different ages (a baby, a toddler, and an older child). Students will work from their own photos in the afternoon under Anna's instruction, and have the option of doing three separate paintings (one for each day), or working on the same one for the duration of the workshop.
