#### Next-Gen Mustang NASCAR Is Built For EV Tech, Says Ford Exec



Ford revealed the next-gen Mustang NASCAR racer back in May following a camouflaged track teaser and an early leak that showed off the new race car in the flesh. Since then, we've gotten a chance to hear its V8 soundtrack as well. The design of the car itself is a bit of a throwback, as it looks far more like the Ford road-going Mustang than its predecessor. But in terms of powertrains, the next-gen Mustang NASCAR racer is much more forward-thinking.

"We're excited about what this platform does," Mark Rushbrook, Global Director of Ford Performance Motorsports, told *Ford Authority* executive editor, Alex Luft, in a

recent interview. "It's an opportunity to future proof. We're great today with what's going to be racing in 2022, but we know as our world is changing with hybrid powertrains, full-electric powertrains, if we were going to do this new car as an industry, we have to make sure it's able to grow with the automotive world – what people are going to be parking in their driveways and garages."

"The ability to have a hybrid in there very easily in the very near future was important to us, something that NASCAR and the industry have already worked on," Rushbrook added. "We're able to do that. That's going to be important so that we can continue learning the technical innovation of hybrid systems, and beyond that

to full electric cars, too. The future is coming pretty quickly. I think we're ready for it."

In addition to future-proofing the new NASCAR Mustang in the powertrain department, it's also considerably different from its predecessor – which has been in service since 2013. The new racer is wider, with a smaller greenhouse area, a new independent rear suspension, and new 18-inch aluminum wheels.

The next-gen NASCAR Ford Mustang will compete in the Cup Series starting next season when it makes its racing debut at the 64<sup>th</sup> annual Daytona 500 at Daytona International Speedway on February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

#### Used Ford Mustang Prices Have Substantially Increased From 2020

Used car prices have skyrocketed in recent months as the semiconductor chip shortage continues to wreak havoc on new vehicle inventory, leading to new records each and every month. Last month, the average used vehicle listing reached \$25k for the first time ever, while even higher-mile used vehicles are selling for big money these days. However, some models are selling for greater premiums than others, and that includes the Lincoln Navigator, as Ford Authority reported yesterday. while used Ford Mustang prices are on the rise as well.



This news comes to us from iSeeCars, which just released new data revolving around the best and worst used cars to buy right now. Of the top ten used vehicles with the largest year-over-year price increases, the Mustang ranked ninth. Average used Ford Mustang prices have risen to \$36,476, a whopping \$10,656 or 41.3 percent more than last June.

"These sports cars are aspirational cars for many consumers, and even with a price increase, they are still relatively affordable compared to other vehicles in the segment," said iSeeCars Executive Analyst Karl Brauer. "Sports cars surged in popularity during the pandemic as drivers sought fun cars to combat boredom, and since they aren't practical purchases, people are likely more willing to pay a premium for them in the used car marketplace."

While this is bad news for anyone in the market for a used Ford Mustang (or most used vehicles in general), there are signs that things may soon cool off at least a little in the coming months. Inventory actually improved in the month of June, and many experts believe that prices will begin to follow suit and start to



decline in Q3.

"These used vehicles have proven to be appreciating assets over the past year – a circumstance not typically associated with used cars," Brauer said. "Shoppers interested in these vehicles should consider holding off on purchasing them, while consumers who have these vehicles in their garage and are willing to part with them can take advantage of significantly higher trade-in values."

#### 2021 Ford Mustang Is Second Most American Vehicle In The World



As *Ford Authority* reported exactly one year ago, the Ford Ranger topped Cars.com's longrunning American-Made Index for 2020.

As many shoppers continue to seek out American-made products, an increasingly difficult task these days, it's nice to know which vehicles are made in the U.S. and with Americanmade components. Now, Cars.com's 2021 American-Made Index has just been released, and things have changed considerably, though the 2021 Ford Mustang is the second most American vehicle in the world.

This year's study consists of 90 vehicles, which are ranked based on five criteria – the location of final assembly, percentage of U.S. and Canadian parts, country of origin for available engines, country of origin for available transmissions, and the number of U.S. manufacturing employees relative to the automaker's footprint.

This year, the Ranger was dethroned by the Tesla Model 3, which is built in Freemont, California. However, the Ford Mustang jumped a whopping 32 spots from last year's finish to come in second, thanks to the fact that the majority of its parts content comes from the U.S. and Canada, including its available engine and transmission choices. Of course, the Mustang is also produced at the Ford Flat Rock Assembly Plant in Michigan.

Unfortunately, the Ranger plummeted from its pole position as the most American vehicle in the world last

year all the way down to 28<sup>th</sup> place this year. The Ranger is produced at the Ford Michigan Assembly Plant, alongside the Ford Bronco, along with various other plants around the world, as Ford's mid-size pickup is a truly global product.


Cars.com doesn't reveal its methodology behind these rankings, so it's hard to say exactly what caused the Ranger to slide so far. Regardless, a number of other Blue Oval models made the cut this year, including the Ford Expedition (11), Lincoln Navigator (20), Lincoln Aviator (21), Ford F-150 (29), Ford Explorer (44), Ford Escape (62), and Lincoln Corsair (64).
