
John's featured Mustang is a 2011 Race Red convertible. It has premium leather with the 3.7 and automatic. Jon had a back-up camera put in which displays

on the Garmin Nav. It has







2022 Ford Mustang lineup expanded with Stealth Edition, California Special

Ford on Wednesday announced two special editions to join the 2022 Mustang lineup. One is a new Stealth Edition based on the Mustang EcoBooost and basically sees the entry-level 'Stang kitted out with an appearance package. The other is the return of the California Special, based on the Mustang GT. They join a previously announced Ice White Edition Appearance Package for the Mustang EcoBoost and Mustang GT (as well as the Mustang Mach-E), which is also a new addition for 2022.

Like other Stealth Edition models from Ford, the Mustang EcoBoost Stealth Edition features black accents for the exterior, including black 19-inch wheels. The car also adopts clear lenses for the LED




taillights, plus backlit treadplates and a unique dash-mounted Mustang badge. No change was made to the powertrain, meaning the car's 2.3-liter turbocharged inline-4 still spits out 310 hp.

As for the California Special, Ford has offered this treatment on multiple generations of the Mustang. It actually dates back to a dealer special introduced for 1968, and on the latest version there are numerous retro styling cues like the blacked-out grille, side racing stripes and rear fender scoop. There are also unique



interior treatments including "GT/CS" logos, a "California Special" script, red contrast stitching, and black suede accents for the doors and seats.





The California Special can be ordered on the Mustang GT Premium. The car's 5.0-liter V-8 is good for 460 hp. Order books for the 2022 Mustang open later this year and first deliveries are scheduled for early 2022.

The 2022 model year is expected to be the last for the current sixth-generation Mustang, the S550, as a redesigned S650 generation using an updated version of the current car's platform is tipped to arrive in time for the 2023 model year.

U.S. Air Force' Tribute Call Sign for Carroll Shelby Is "Snake Charmer," Of Course



Heralded as one of the greatest car guys that ever lived, Carroll Hall Shelby would have been almost a century old by now. If not for the tragic moment in spring 2012, when the designer, race driver, and entrepreneur had to "race" in search of the plains of automotive Valhalla...

Fret not, because his memory will live on forever. And, possibly, his annual Birthday Bash will do the same. But for 2021, the event celebrating 98 years since the birth of the Shelby man had a handful of interesting premieres. One of them would be the alleged decision by the United States Air Force to grant a huge tribute to Carroll.

It's a 2021 Mustang Signature Edition "with a patriotic livery package that pays tribute to Carroll Shelby" and the Air Force at the same time.

As such, the Whipple supercharger-equipped Blue Oval has 825 horsepower, the Shelby widebody pack, Extreme Cooling pack, Shelby by Borla exhaust system, Ford Performance Track Handling goodies, as well as a bundle of bespoke enhancements. Among them, a unique Aviation-tribute livery, one-off Shelby wheels, as well as a bespoke Katzkin Leather Red, White, and Blue cockpit treatment.

This 1-0f-1 Shelby will go to one lucky Shelby/Air Force aficionado thanks to a raffle taking place during the 2022 Kansas City Air Show, with donations to benefit the Children's Mercy Kansas City children's hospital!


