The 2015 Mustang GT with the GT Performance Package includes a strut-tower brace, larger radiator, larger rear sway bar, heavy-duty front spring, K-Brace, Brembo 6-piston front calipers with larger rotors, staggered 19-inch gloss black alloy wheels, retuned EPAS, ABS, and stability control systems, 3.73 Torsen rear axle, gauges package (oil pressure and vacuum) and rear spoiler delete.

In addition: I have added Magnaflow performance exhausts mufflers, Saleen progressive springs, Airaid MXP Cold Air Intake, Ford performance radiator cover, radiator extension covers, strut tower covers, billet retro 6-speed shift knob and other miscellaneous chrome and detail accent parts

To date, the Competition Orange has only been offered on four model years of the Mustang: 2004, 2012, 2015 and 2016. Although I drive it to club meeting, events, and car shows it only has a little over 10,000 miles. It's been an awesome Mustang.

As most of you know, my spouse is Melinda Morales, our Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, and Raffle Chairperson ... and best Secretary ever! I also have two daughters, two son-in-law's and two granddaughters living in Wesley Chapel and they are the reason we moved to Tampa, Florida.

My two sons-in-law's have been very influenced by my love for Ford and Mustangs. One son-in-law, Cesar (also a BAM! member), was into Mazda's and now he owns two beautiful Mustangs that he shows at the various local car shows. His daily driver is a beautiful F-150. 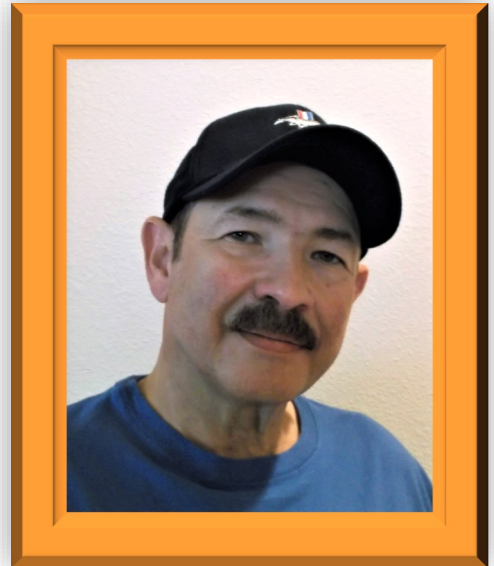
We always have an informative guest speaker and we play fun games to make us all laugh. I want to thank Ford's Garage for allowing us to have our monthly Gathering in their patio.

2024 Ford Mustang: Everything We Know

Ford's seventh-generation pony car debuts in September 2022.
Our exclusive renderings suggest an evolutionary approach to styling.

The age of automobiles with internal-combustion engines is nearly over, but it's not over yet for the Ford Mustang. An all-new pony car will debut in September 2022, and while we don't know the long-term plan for Ford's enduring war horse, the seventh generation will start the same way the first gen did nearly 60 years ago: by converting gasoline into noise, tire smoke, and grins.

We've seen camouflaged Mustang prototypes out and about for several months now, in coupe and convertible format. Ford officials have also dropped some hints about what's coming for the next-gen car, and some of those "hints" have been straight-up confirmations. As such, there's quite a bit we already know about the forthcoming Mustang, from styling cues to mechanical components.



While the Dodge Challenger is poised to lose its V8 for the next generation, Ford Mustang buyers can still get one. An early spy video captured a V8 Mustang prototype on the move, clearly emitting a throaty soundtrack. A late August Instagram teaser reinforced that point. Sometime later, a Ford executive straight-up confirmed that yes, the new Mustang will keep its V8 engine. That almost certainly means the 5.0-liter V8, which could be massaged to produce a bit more than the 450 horsepower currently offered.

However, there's a curious V8 wildcard that surfaced back in 2020. The former president of Unifor, a major Canadian trade union connected to the auto industry, said Ford would offer a new 6.8-liter V8 engine in "derivatives for the Mustang and F-150." This engine would come from Ford's Windsor, Ontario assembly plant, as mentioned in a press release from Unifor. Ford never offered additional information on the engine, and nothing has been heard since. But a public statement from a union president is hard to ignore.

(Continued from Page 8) V8s aside, the turbocharged 2.3-liter four-cylinder engine is expected to carry over from the current model. But what about electric power? That's the big question surrounding the seventh-generation pony, as rumors say this could be the point when Ford offers a plug-in hybrid Mustang with all-wheel drive. Nothing of the sort has been confirmed or even teased by Ford, so at the very least, we don't expect anything electrified at launch.

Regardless of the engine, row-your-own enthusiasts can still manage power the old-fashioned way. Ford has confirmed the new Mustang will offer a six-speed manual transmission, in addition to an automatic.

2024 Ford Mustang Styling

Ford isn't rocking the boat when it comes to the Mustang's design. Our exclusive 2024 Ford Mustang renderings peel back the camouflage from numerous prototype sightings and leaked images to reveal a slightly larger grille for the GT model, dropping further into the lower fascia in a fashion similar to the current Mustang Shelby GT500. Corner vents should grow larger as well, and headlights will adopt a thinner, clean look. On EcoBoost models, the grille should remain the same but the lower fascia might have smaller vents.

In profile, don't expect the new Mustang to differ significantly from the outgoing model. The wheelbase appears the same, and the pony car's

proportions – a long hood in front with a steeply raked fastback in the rear – look extremely similar. The C-pillar on the new car seems thinner, leaving more room for larger side windows. And though we've yet to have a clear view of the new 'Stang's taillights, we'd be absolutely shocked if Ford doesn't keep the iconic three three-bar vertical design.

As for upgrade packages and trim levels, we've already seen a prototype sporting aggressive exhaust tips, upgraded brakes, and super-sticky tires. This all but confirms the availability of a GT performance package, and special edition trims like the California Special should arrive eventually. A high-performance Shelby model is expected to return, though that's likely a bit further down the road. There's no word yet on the availability of limited-run models like the Mach 1, Boss, or Bullitt.

2024 Ford Mustang Interior

Less is known about the new Mustang's greenhouse, but it should retain a rather conventional layout. Regardless of the transmission, a lever will rise from the center console to select gears. A larger center touchscreen display will sit above the console in a simplified dash that eliminates some – but not all – tactile controls. A separate digital display is expected for the driver, but Mustang interior spy photos suggest they won't be connected under a single large screen as we're seeing with brands like BMW. The availability of advanced technology like Ford's Blue Cruise system is unknown at this time.

2024 Ford Mustang Price

Pricing information isn't available yet for the seventh-generation Mustang. The current model starts at \$28,865 for an EcoBoost with a six-speed manual transmission. The V8-powered GT starts at \$39,440, also equipped with a six-speed stick. It's safe to assume pricing for the 2024 Mustang will be higher, but given the steady decline of Mustang sales in recent years, we'd be surprised if Ford launched the new model with a significantly higher MSRP. 2024 Ford Mustang Debut

Ford is pulling out all the stops to make the seventh-generation Mustang debut something special. The covers officially come off on September 14 at a special event in downtown Detroit, at Hart Plaza, scheduled for 8:00 pm EDT. However, Ford is holding two events that will bring Mustang owners to the Motor City for the action, starting on September 6 with a cross-country drive called *The Drive Home*. It starts in Tacoma Washington and includes stops in nine states, and Ford invites Mustang owners to join for any (or all) of the trip. It ends at Ford World Headquarters in Dearborn on September 14, at which point *The Stampede* begins.

The Stampede is a big Mustang cruise from Ford HQ to the debut location. It starts at 5:00 pm as Mustang owners arrive at the Dearborn headquarters. The cruise departs at 5:30 pm and is

scheduled to reach downtown at 6:30 pm. The seventh-generation Mustang debut takes place at 8:00 pm, and participants in *The Stampede* are invited to an after-party running until 10:00 pm. There's even a costume party as part of the fun, with the winner receiving a free 24-month lease on a new Mustang GT.

The Drive Home and *The Stampede* are open to the public, however, there is limited space for *The Stampede* and registration is required. Ford asks those interested to register online at mustangstampededetroit.com. Registration is first-come-first-serve.

2024 Ford Mustang Availability

At this point, details beyond the Mustang's debut are unknown. Ford should offer a general timeframe for production and deliveries at the debut, though we expect it will reach dealerships in the summer of 2023 at the latest.

Forget chips, Ford is running out of its Blue Oval badges

Ford has been forced to hold back deliveries on some models because it is running out of badges — yep, the Blue Oval that adorns their vehicles inside and (sometimes) out. Some individual model emblems are also in short supply, the *Wall Street Journal* says, and unlike bandits in the Sierra Madre, Ford execs believe very strongly that they need those stinkin' badges. Per the report, Ford's recent supply-chain issues are largely related to non-semiconductor components, meaning chips are no longer the driving concern. Ford executives were presented with the option of supplementing badge production (and perhaps other parts, though this was not specified) with 3D-printed substitutes, however concerns about meeting quality standards reportedly sidelined the proposal. The shortage is hitting the company's F-Series pickups the hardest, which may explain why they're again stacking up in auxiliary holding lots.

While many supply chain issues stem from logistical congestion far from home, Ford's headaches could be at least partly to blame on local suppliers. Tribar, which produces plated exterior trim parts (and, at least in the past, has produced badges for Ford), was recently in the news for discharging carcinogenic hexavalent chromium into a tributary of Michigan's Huron River. Chromium is used in the plating process. When the spill was detected by local wastewater treatment facilities, Tribar was forced to shut its effluent discharge system, limiting its ability to operate. The company was granted approval to resume discharging wastewater in September.

YOU COULD WIN THIS 1966 SHELBY GT350H HERTZ RENT-A-RACER

The Ford Mustang is famous for a lot of things, and has forged a decades-long love affair with enthusiasts and those simply seeking a fun car to drive. However, the Mustang is also known for becoming Hertz's original "Rent-a-Racer" back in the 1960s, a pretty wild idea that involved what were essentially street-legal racers anyone could roll in, rent, and take to the local track, then return

when the weekend was over. Original Rent-a-Racers like this 1966 Shelby GT350H are quite valuable today, but one lucky person is going to win this one thanks to a new



sweepstakes from The Cobra Experience.

This 1966 Shelby GT350H is the real deal, finished in the iconic Hertz black and gold livery with a full ownership history listed in the SAAC directory and a feature in the August 1993 *Mustang Monthly* magazine under its belt. It was originally delivered to Hertz in Cleveland by The Marshall Motor Co., in Mayfield Heights, Ohio on April 29th, 1966, and retains its original Shelby VIN plate, shipping and maintenance documents, as well as all of the requisite, verified Ford serial numbers.

This 1966 Shelby GT350H – which bears the serial number SFM6S1796 – is equipped with Ford's K-

Code 289 cubic-inch Cobra V8 that generates 306 horsepower and 329 pound-feet of torque, which is mated to a C4 automatic transmission and a nine-inch rear end.

As if this amazing car wasn't enough of a prize on its own accord, proceeds from the sweepstakes benefit The Cobra Experience – a 501(c)(3) non-

profit museum located in Martinez, California – which has a mission to promote, conserve, educate and preserve the cars produced by Shelby American. In addition, it seeks to expand and continually develop its programs to educate the public and the next

generation of automotive enthusiasts about the legacy of Carroll Shelby and his great cars.

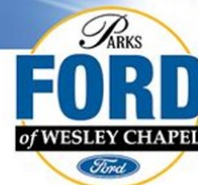
