

MISSIONARY LETTER FROM CHORRERA – AMAZON JUNE 2023

Dear brothers in Christ and fellows in the ministry, may receive a fraternal hug. It would be impossible to fulfill the great commission individually, the intercessors, and/or givers are as important as those of us in the field. So, each one of you is highly esteemed before the Lord and each one will be rewarded by our Heavenly Father.

A month has passed and we are filled with gratitude for what He allowed us to do for His glory. Happy with my wife's company this month and the visit of 5 brothers from Medellín from the Pan-American church. We managed to make a missionary trip down the river, from June 22nd to July 5th. We stayed for two days in Port-Milan days, 5 days in Providencia. We worked with three communities in there who belong to the Bora ethnic group. We stayed 5 days in Cris which belong to a Huitoto community and this one is a big community and one of the most distant ones. In both locations we did an evangelistic work with children, adolescents and adults. The receptivity for the gospel from a group of people in each community comforted and encouraged us. It is sad to leave them alone when they need a follow up and discipleship but we ask God to allow us to go back to them for a longer time soon to start bible studies with them.

The spiritual atmosphere in the CRIS community was heavy, because witchcraft moves strongly. The first night we could hardly sleep, but after praying we saw disposition in several families to gather and listen to the Word of God. People were very grateful for our visit and were asking us to come back again. In the community of Providencia, the door is open for missionaries who want to go and live there. It was possible to deliver several proclaimers (New Testament in audio and native language) in the Bora and Huitoto communities that we visited.

In Chorrera, we continue the work with children, Christian meetings and home visitation.

We continue to believe for the salvation of many souls throughout this territory, the need is enormous and the workers are few, but let us continue praying to the Lord of the harvest to send workers to his harvest.

Sending a big hug for each one. We continue to thank the Lord for your lives and praying for Him to be the one who prospers you in everything you undertake, and that your homes be surrounded with His care and protection.
