MINISTERIAL ACHIEVEMENTS:

During the months of May and June we continued to train the missionaries who are being trained by us. The last weeks of May we guided them so they can do their mid-year practice where they will share the gospel to children, youth and adults in the indigenous communities Ticunas, Cocamas and Yaguas. They will be sharing the gospel to not reached places and to the less reached places by the gospel on the Atacuari and Loretoyacu rivers, this time to three communities specifically:

1. Indigenous community of the Cocama-Yagua ethnic group, called “7 de Agosto”. (Atacuari River)
2. Indigenous community of the Yagua Ethnic Group called “el Sol”. (Atacuari River)
3. Indigenous community of the Ticuna ethnic group called “Santa Teresita”. (Loretoyacu River).

#### Community of "7 de Agosto" (Atacuari River)

On the last day of our stay in this community, at night, our Missionaries in formation preached the gospel and 15 people received Christ into their lives. They were people who were already listening to the message of Jesus but had not yet taken the step of accepting Him and now they decided to follow Him. Now, the pastor of the community next door, his name is Hernán Ipuchima, is discipling these people. We talked about Jesus to more than 125 children and 55 of them attended to one complete week of teachings and the parents were very grateful for these teachings.

Now, we plan to train them in the next three months in the theoretical-practical area. After that they will go for two months to practice in a community where there are no churches and where the gospel has never been preached. They will be assigned to two very distant and difficult places, but we trust that our good God has called us to instruct a generation that will carry the message that will change their generations and will bring salvation to their ethnic groups.
